ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Before your arrival, all students must complete the Clearwater Central Catholic enrollment process through the FACTS Family Portal.

Please follow the steps below carefully:

STEP 1 — CREATE YOUR FACTS ACCOUNT

1. Access the FACTS Family Portal
2. District Code: **ccchs-fl**
3. Click on Create New Family Portal Account
4. Enter the **same email** address used during the school application
5. Click on Create Account

You will receive an email from FACTS SIS Customer Support with a link to create your username and password.

Important:

- The link is active for only 6 hours
- Create a NEW username and password
- Do not use the same credentials from the application process

STEP 2 — ACCESS THE ENROLLMENT FORM

After creating your account:

1. Log into the FACTS Family Portal
2. Enter your username and password
3. Click on Apply/Enroll in the left menu
4. Select Enrollment/Reenrollment



ACADEMICS & COURSE SELECTION

- Students will meet with their assigned counselor after enrollment.
- Course selection is completed with counselor guidance.
- Meetings may occur virtually before arrival or in person after arrival.
- Counselors will help students choose courses according to graduation requirements, English level, interests, and future goals.
- Students should regularly check their email for communications from their counselor.

- ✓ Wear clothes you might travel in, if possible.

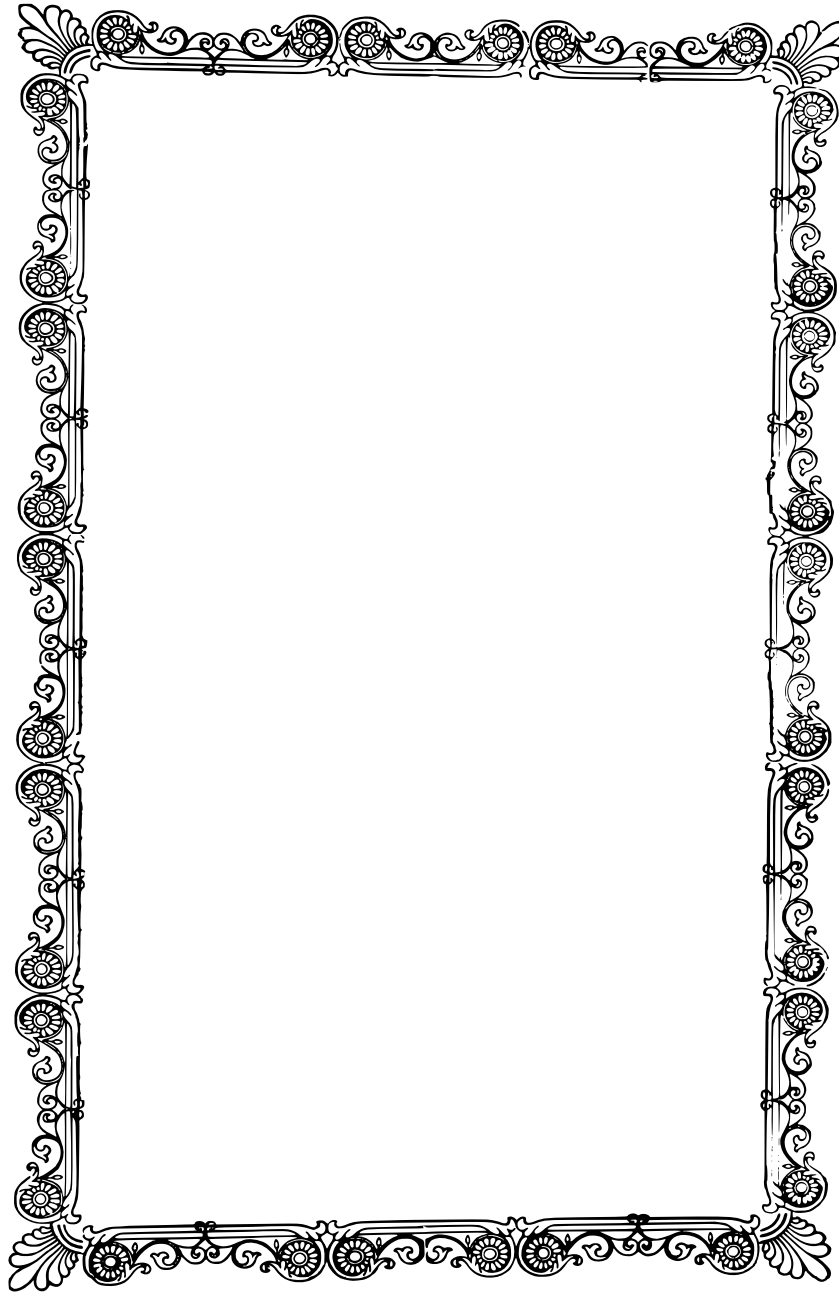
