Visa Share Code

To help us prepare for your arrival and ensure that your enrolment process runs smoothly, please send us your UK Visa Share Code as soon as it becomes available.

Providing your share code in advance allows our team to complete the necessary immigration checks and have everything ready for your arrival at Bosworth Independent School.

Student ID Photo

We kindly ask all students to send a recent passport-style ID photograph to our wonderful Student Communications Team.

Your photograph will be used to prepare important school systems and identification materials before you arrive.

- Photo requirements:
- Clear, recent photograph
- Plain background preferred
- Head and shoulders visible
- Good lighting
- JPEG or PNG format

Airport Transfer Booking



Bosworth Independent School can arrange airport transfers from major UK airports, including:

To ensure a smooth arrival and safe journey to the boarding house, all students requiring an airport transfer must submit their travel details no later than 31st July.

Do not leave the airport with anyone you do not recognise or who is not authorised by the school.

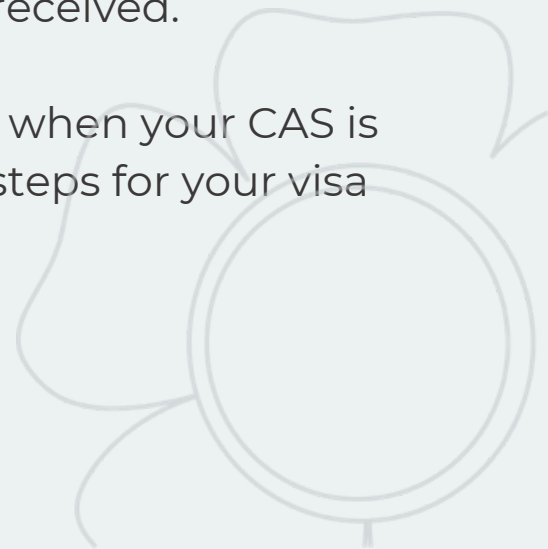
Student Visa & CAS Information



Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS)

For students who require a Student Visa to study in the UK, please note that CAS statements will be generated and issued throughout the summer period once all admission requirements have been met and the necessary documentation has been received.

The Student Comms will contact you directly when your CAS is ready and will provide guidance on the next steps for your visa application.

Money & Insurance

Insurance

Banking

Students will need access to a bank account and a payment card that can be used in the UK for everyday expenses.

If you do not already have a suitable account, our staff can assist you with opening a UK bank account after your arrival.



Cash

Students should avoid carrying large amounts of cash.

- Students should never have more than £200 in cash.
- We recommend using a bank card for most purchases where possible.

If you have any questions about banking, insurance, or managing money in the UK, our Boarding Team will be happy to help and provide guidance after your arrival.
