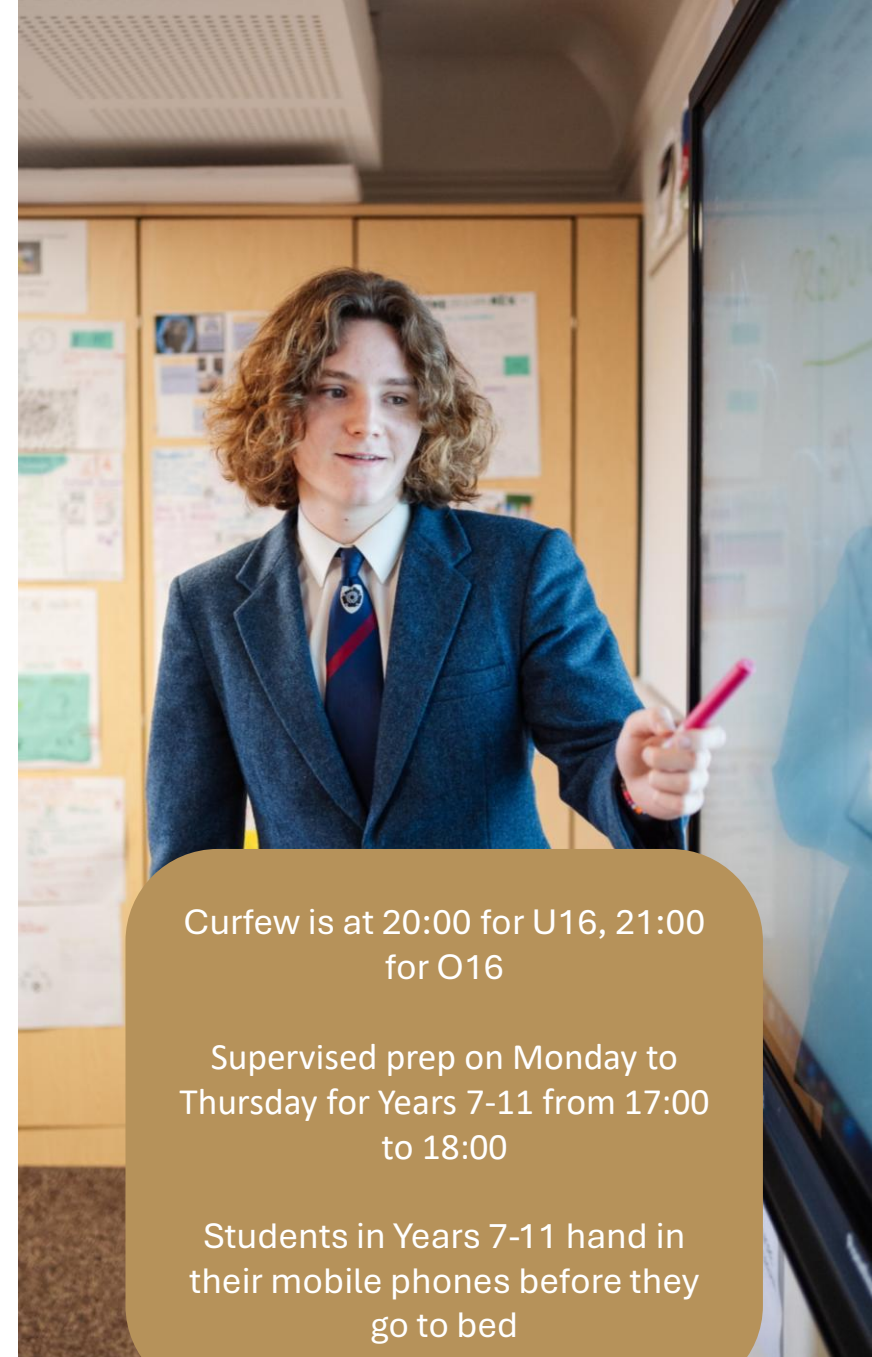

Uniform: Year 7 to Year 11– HST (1 or 2 Terms)

Uniform and PE Kit

All students must wear their lanyard at all times while on the school site.

Uniform Year 7 – Year 11

Students should wear an Oxford blue shirt, with navy blue trousers, or knee length skirt. A jumper blazer from Stevenson's, our supplier, should also be worn as compulsory parts of the uniform. Students are expected to have shirts tucked in.

Footwear

Students should wear flat, black or tan leather shoes of sensible design to protect and support the feet. No trainers, canvas pumps or stiletto heels.

PE Kit

Students in Years 7-11 should have the school's PE kit which is available only from our supplier, Stevenson's. There are a variety of elements available such as shorts, track pants, sports tops and mid-layers. The Stevenson's website shows the compulsory items.

Uniform: Year 12 and Year 13 (A Level and UFP)

Uniform Year 12 – Year 13

Students are expected to wear Smart Business Wear, including smart trousers or tailored skirts, smart shirts or blouses, jumpers or cardigans, and formal shoes.

Medical and Wellbeing support

We have a registered Nurse in school Monday to Friday.

The School Nurse will arrange to register all new boarding students with the local doctor's clinic which we are linked to. This is just a 2-minute walk from school.

The School Nurse offers confidential advice to students and can refer to specialist services. We also have a counselling service in school free of charge available to all. The nurse and counsellor will introduce themselves on arrival to each student.

If a student is ill in the Boarding House and/or ill overnight, they must inform their Houseparent who will contact the School Nurse and arrange for an appointment as soon as possible.

If a student is taking medication and needs to continue taking at school or in boarding, parents must contact the school nurse before arrival to update school and boarding. All medication must be disclosed to school in advance and on arrival to house parents.

Exeats

Students must submit an exeat on our platform **Reach** if they would like to go on a day trip, overnight stay and for travelling internationally. This must then be approved before the student can leave.

We encourage students to explore the amazing places we have good access to from Northampton, such as London, Oxford, Cambridge and Birmingham.

- The address for Bosworth Hall is 33-35 St George' Avenue, Northampton, Northamptonshire, NN2 6JA.



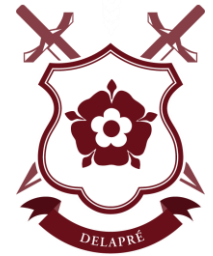
Communicating Home
